A. 1130 North L Street (North Slope Special Review District)

Background:

In July and August, 2008, the Commission reviewed the proposal for replacing seven existing wood with Milgard fiberglass windows on the side and rear elevations at 1130 North L Street. The Commission requested estimates for restoration. In addition, the Commission asked the Architectural Review Committee to conduct a site visit to inspect the condition of the existing windows and make a determination and proposal to bring back to the next ARC meeting.

The estimates were submitted in October 2008 and the site visit was conducted last week, April 24, 2009 by two Commissioners and Staff.

The applicant seeks guidance and feedback from the Commission prior to final review and action on the application.

This is an informal review. No action will be taken on this item at this time.
